

Private Studios at Spudnik Press Cooperative



Overview

Six private studios provide long-term space for artists to develop their artistic practice at Spudnik Press Cooperative. Studios are housed within a larger shared studio space. There are a total of six private studios, three each in the Printshop and the Annex. All studios includes A/C, heat, wireless internet, utilities and 24/7 Access to a secure building. Private studios have hardwood floors, 8 foot walls, high ceilings, and a locking door. There is a shared parking lot for the building. Application Process

Applications are reviewed in the order they are received. Applications serve the purpose of verifying income and ensuring that there is a good cultural fit between the artist and the greater community. Once an application is accepted, a one-month fully-refundable security deposit secures the studio for the artist.

Lease

All studios begin with a six-month lease, followed by month-to-month rental. After the initial lease, artists must give a minimum of 30-days notice to receive their full security deposit. After the initial lease, artists may request a longer lease. Artists will also be asked to sign a Rules and Regulations contract.

Annex Studios

Housed within a 600 square foot shared workspace, classroom, and gallery, the studio includes access to self-publishing resources and a small library. Our fully equipped community printshop is one door away (24/7 access available for additional \$100/month).

Annex East: 8x13'; 104 sq. feet. Has hot water heat in corner of studio.

Annex Center: 7x13'; 91 sq. feet

Annex West: 10x13', 130 sq. feet

Printshop Studios

Housed within a 2,400 square foot shared workspace and community printshop. Ideal for active printmakers, as keyholder access to full print studio is included. Ink and general print supplies included (See website for details). Includes 24-hour access to onsite self-publishing resources, photocopier, and library one door away. Studios in the Printshop each have a west-facing window.

Printshop South: 7x15'; 105 sq. feet

Printshop Center: 10x15'; 150 sq. feet

Printshop North: 8x15'; 120 sq. feet
